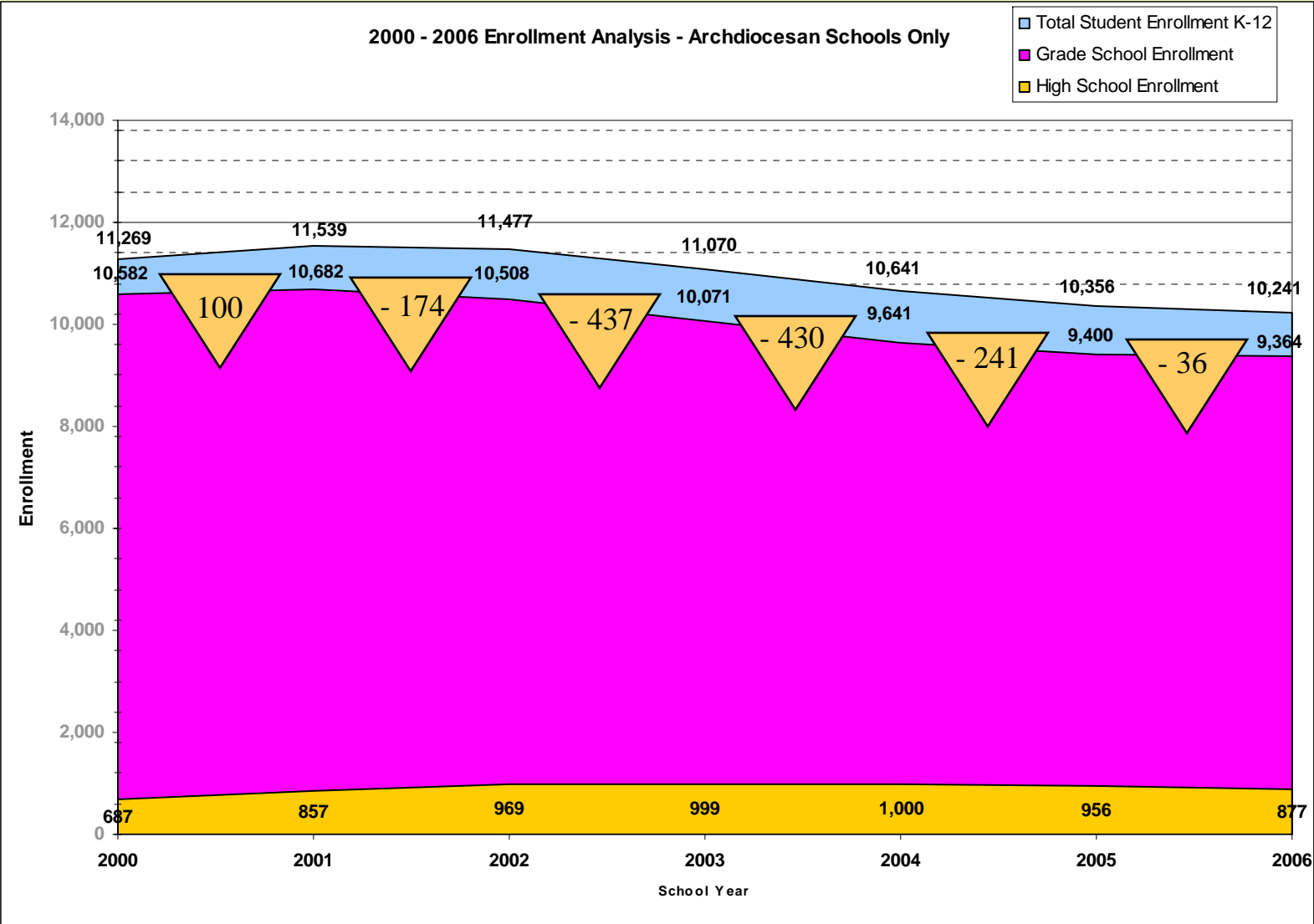

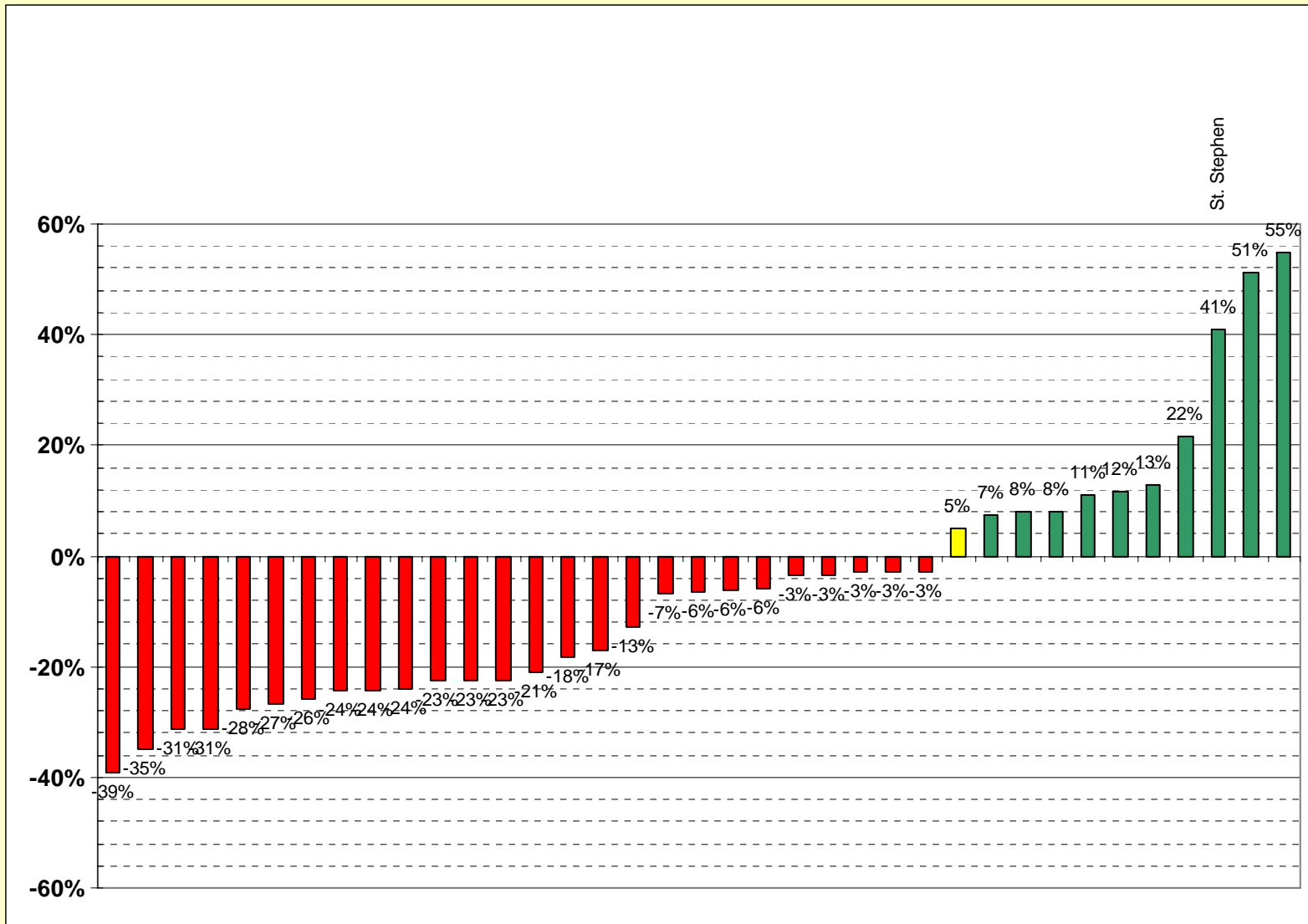

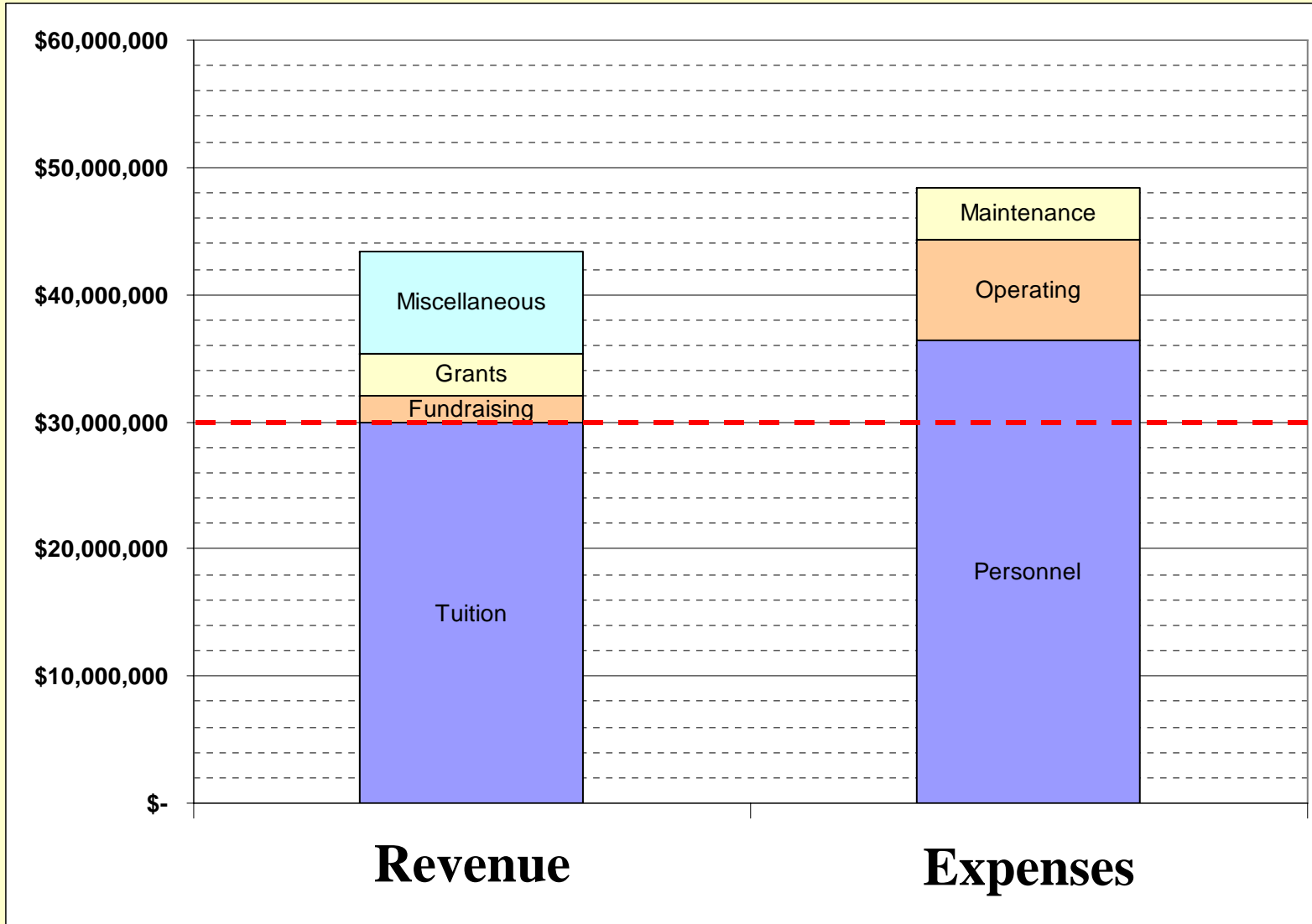
Overall 5-Year Trend



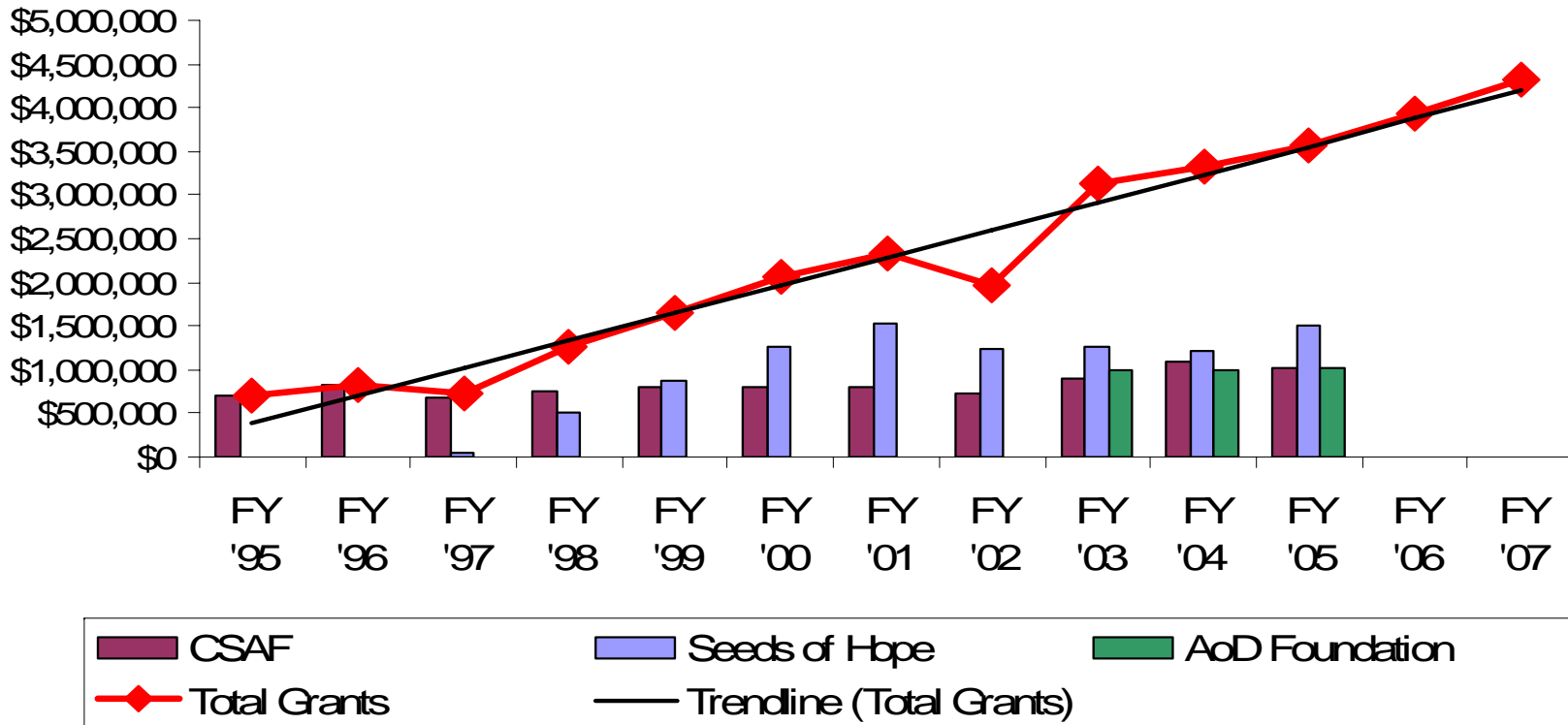
5-Year Snapshot 2002 – 2006 Enrollment

Projection of School Subsidy Need



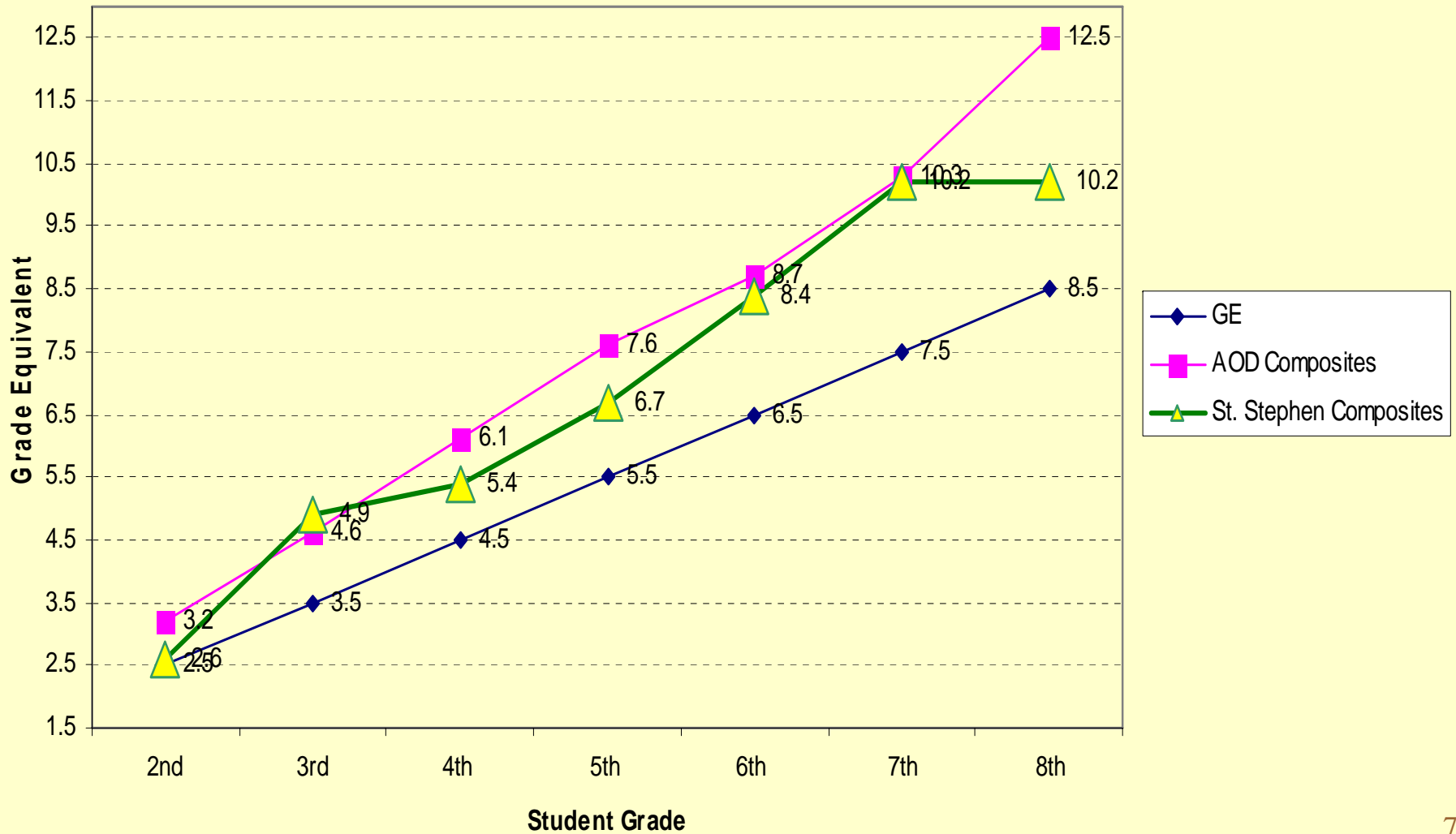
2005 – 2006 Tuition Rates

- Rates higher for non-affiliated Catholics

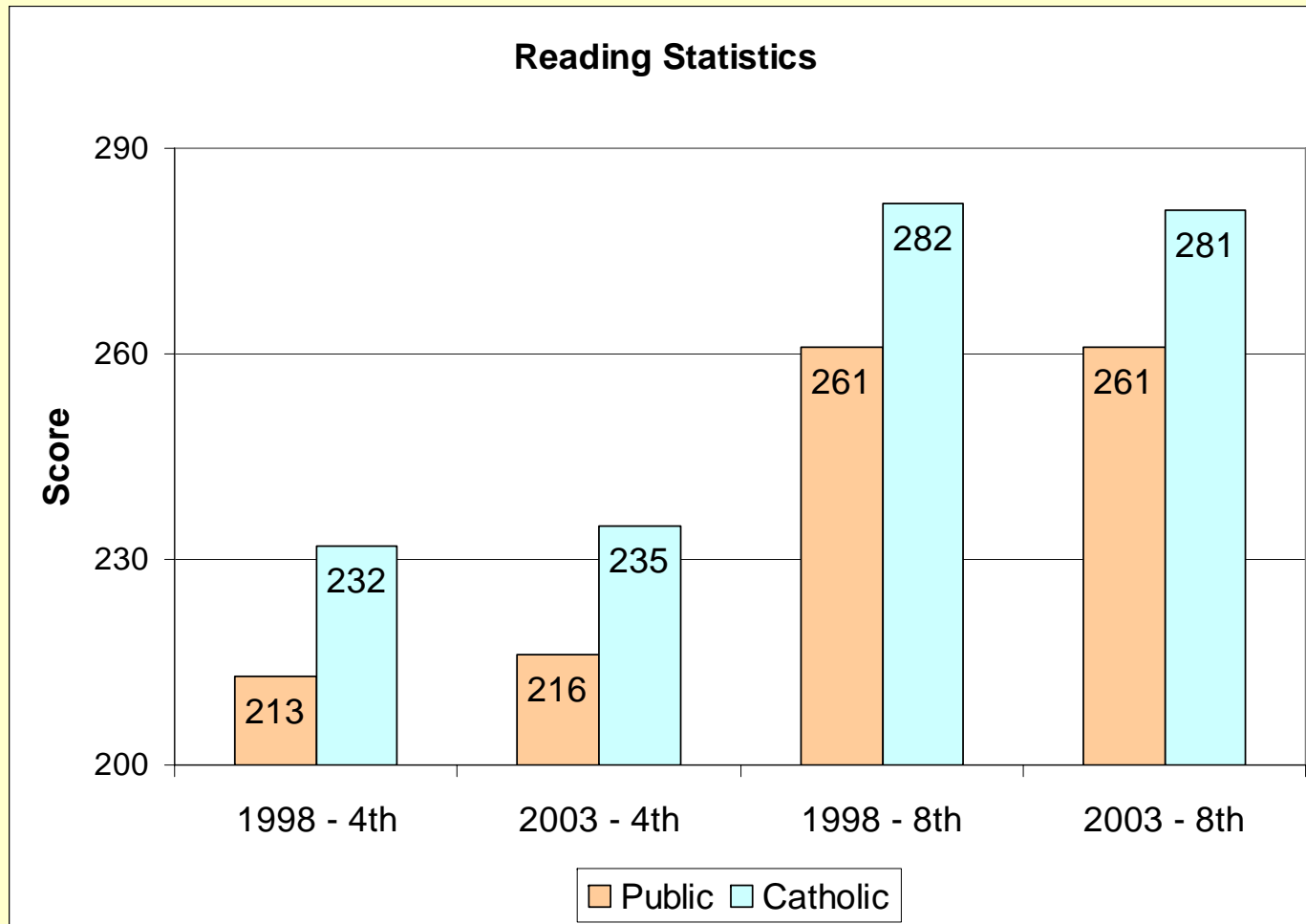

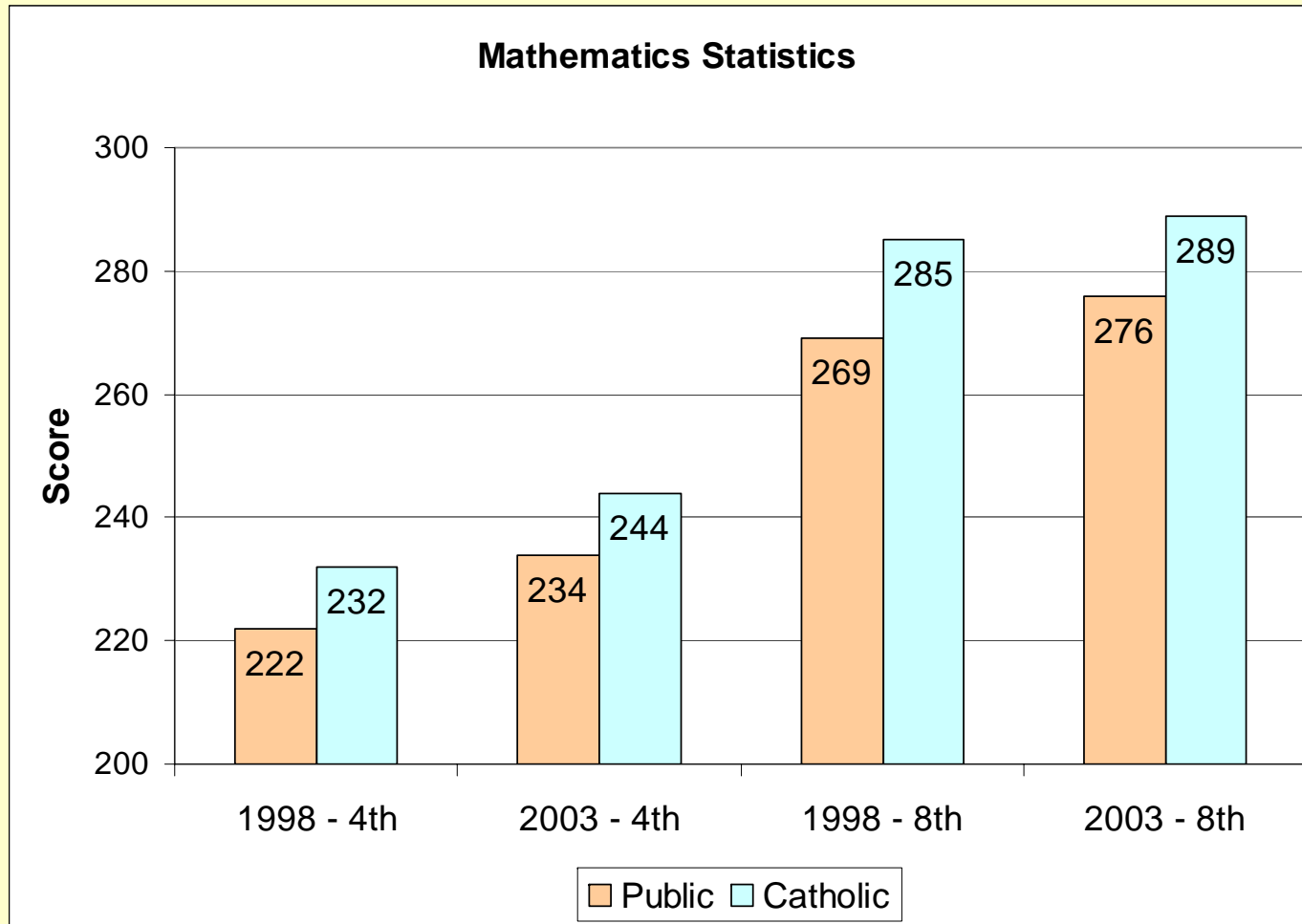
2005 ITBS Average Composite Scores



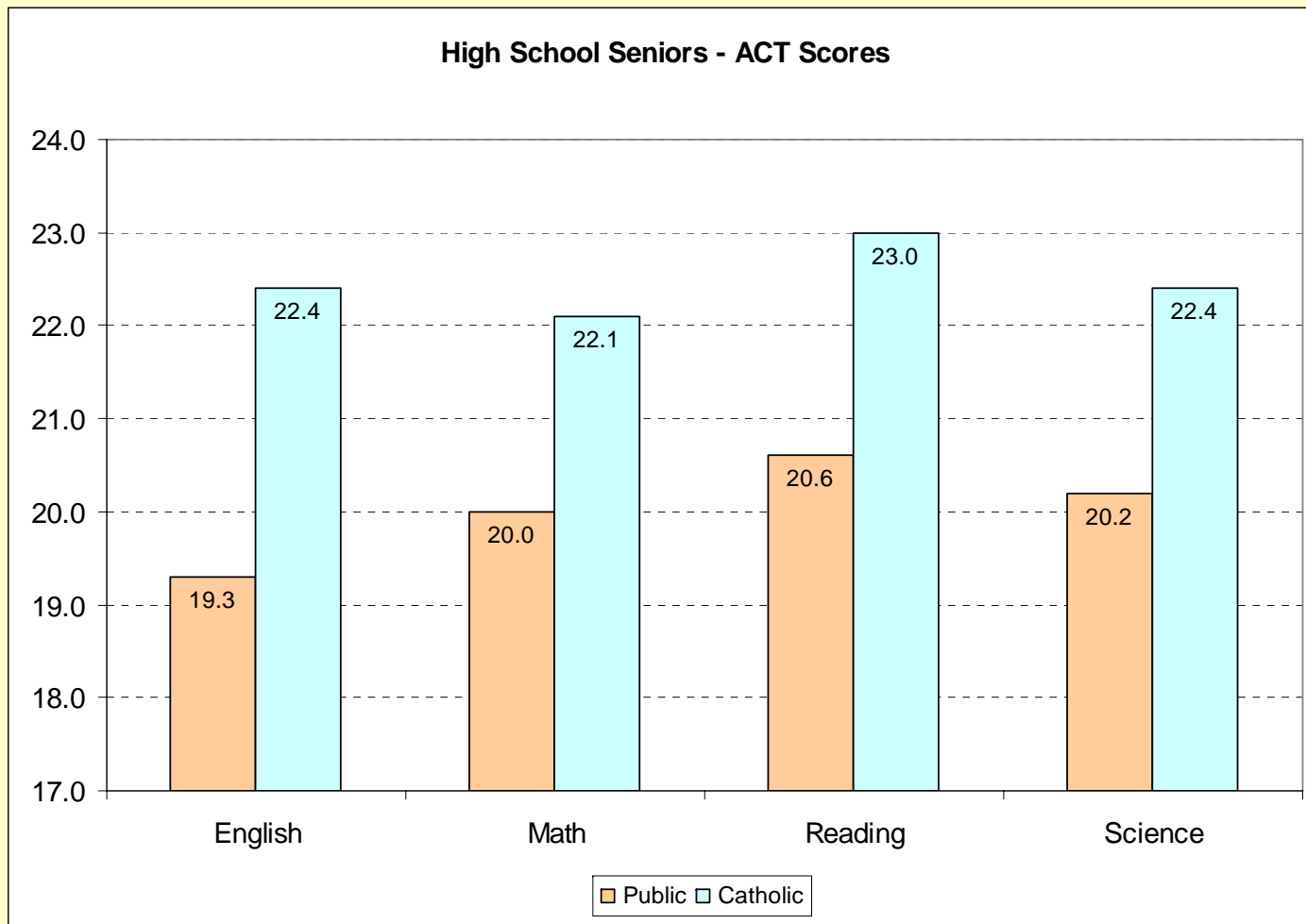
Highest Academic Quality

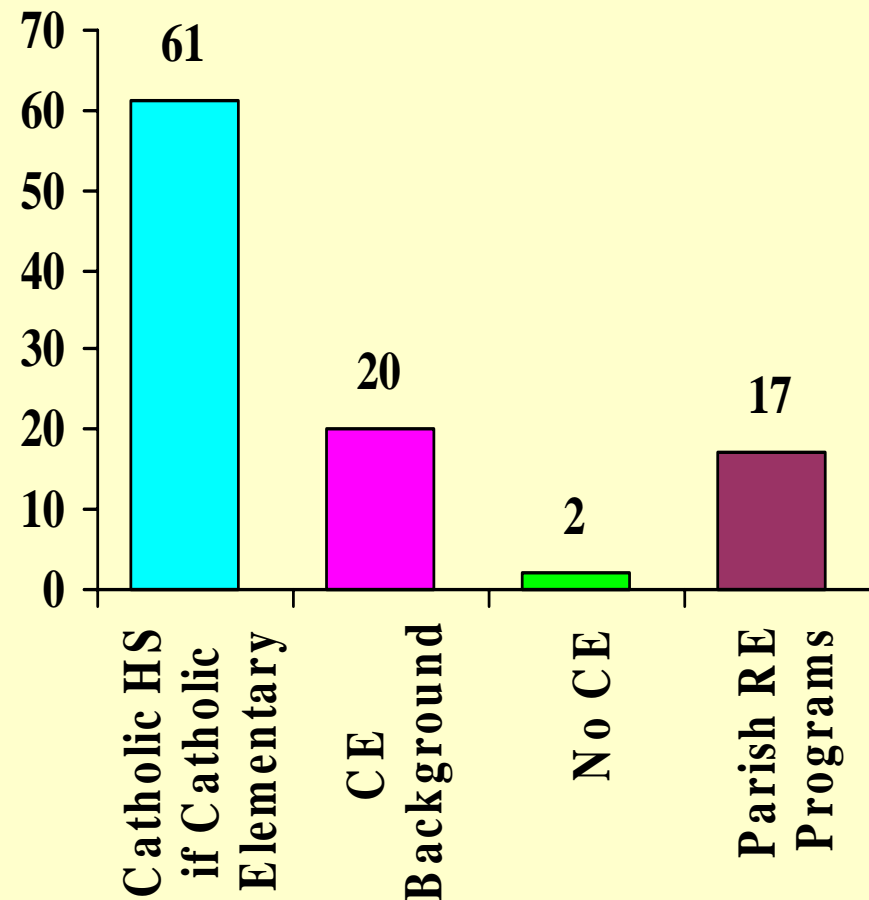


ACT Scores – High School Seniors



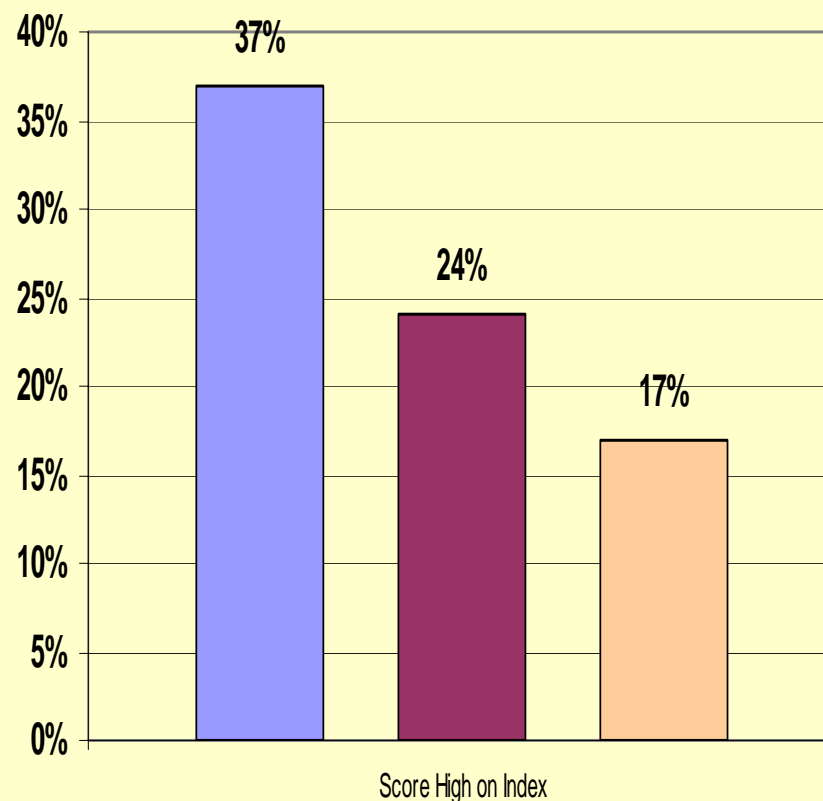
Religious Outcomes

 - Mystical Body
 - Eighth Commandment
 - Incarnation
 - Grace, judgment, and papal encyclicals



Religious Outcomes for Adults who attended Catholic Schools

- Adults scoring high on the Sacramental Index as a measure of religious practices:
 - Attend Mass at least weekly;
 - Receive Communion at least several times a month;
 - Go to Confession once a month;
 - and pray daily
