Two Liturgical Texts in Spanish Closer to Publication

October, 2008 – The October, 2008 *NewsLetter* of the USCCB Committee on Divine Worship reported that the *Ritual para el Bautismo de los Niños* and *Ritual de Matrimonio* have received necessary approval and now move closer to publication... ([read more](#))

“As a result of fruitful discussions and a review of several editorial changes made to the document, Francis Cardinal Arinze, Prefect of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, granted the *recognitio* for two liturgical texts in Spanish: the *Ritual para el Bautismo de los Niños* (Rite of Baptism of Children) and the *Ritual del Matrimonio* (Rite of Marriage). The Latin Church members of the USCCB, meeting in plenary assembly in November 2004, approved the Baptism and Marriage Rites in Spanish. Spanish-speaking Catholics will now have one Spanish language version of these rites for Marriage and the Baptism of Children approved for use in the dioceses of the United States of America. Once publication issues have been addressed, a decree will be issued indicating the effective dates of the new ritual texts”.
