Guadalupe Shelter - Greeley, Colorado



On Dec. 9, 1931 Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared to local peasant Juan Diego. She would greet Juan with these kind words, "the most humble of my sons", "my son the least," "my little dear".

On August 27, 2011 Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Denver opened a new 13,000 sq. ft. Community Center in Greeley to greet, with the same affection that the Lady welcomed little Juan Diego, the estimated 2,500 - 3,000 homeless men, women and children in Weld County. In addition to providing single rooms for 24 single men, a dorm for six single women, and six individual family rooms, health services and tutors for the children are also provided.
