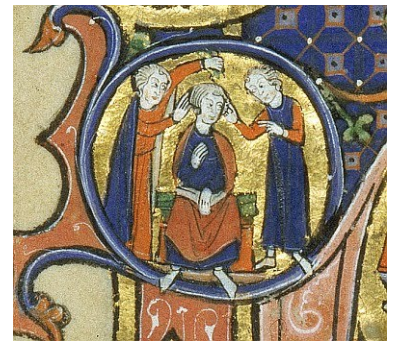
“If every man is our brother, much more must be the sick, the suffering and those in need of care be, at the center of our attention, so that none of them feels forgotten or emarginated; indeed, the true measure of humanity is essentially determined in relationship to suffering and to the sufferer. This holds true both for the individual and for society. A society unable to accept its suffering members and incapable of helping to share their suffering, and to bear it inwardly through “com-*passion*” is a cruel and inhuman society.”



The Anointing of the Sick - Strength and Peace

“The Lord himself showed great concern for the bodily and spiritual welfare of the sick and commanded his apostles to do likewise. Those who are seriously ill need the special help of God’s grace in this time of anxiety, lest they be broken in spirit and, under the pressure of temptation, perhaps weakened in their faith. That is why through this sacrament Christ strengthens the faithful, providing them with the strongest means of support (Pastoral Care of the Sick, #5).”
