Archbishop Fulton Sheen

Archbishop Fulton Sheen (1895-1970) was one of the world’s first televangelists. His program entitled “*Life is Worth Living*” aired on black and white network television from 1951 to 1957 and his later program, “*The Fulton Sheen Program*” aired from 1961 to 1968. What Ever Happened to the Human Race?

Francis August Schaeffer

Francis August Schaeffer (1912-1884) was an Evangelical Protestant theologian and philosopher often described by Protestants as the “last modern theologian”. He was fiercely opposed to theological Modernism, a Christian intellectual, cultural critic, author, noted speaker and founder of the L’Abri Fellowship in Switzerland. While modernism dismissed God and redefined the human person, Schaeffer, like Archbishop

Sheen, Blessed Pope John Paul II, and Pope Benedict XVI insisted there is a God, truth exists, and the human person is exceptional in the created world.

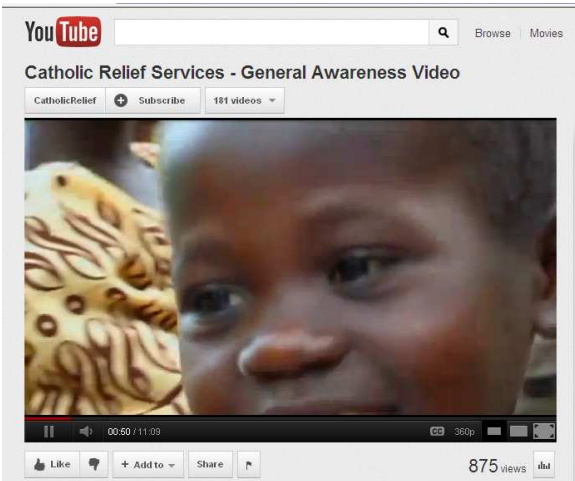


"Epic" from Catholics Come Home Tom Peterson, Founder & President
