of pilgrims as the Patron of Catalonia. The Escolania, one of Europe's oldest boys' choirs, its beginning dates back to the 13th Century, can be heard daily at the Monastery. Early afternoon departure for Barcelona with a stop to visit the Cathedral. The present Cathedral, built to replace a Romanesque Church, was begun at the end of the 13th Century and completed in 1450. Next we visit the Sagrada Familia Church. After dinner a lovely Barcelona by night tour. We will visit the Tibidabo Hill that offers a beautiful panorama of Barcelona, the harbor and one of the world's most famous water fountains. (CB, D)
