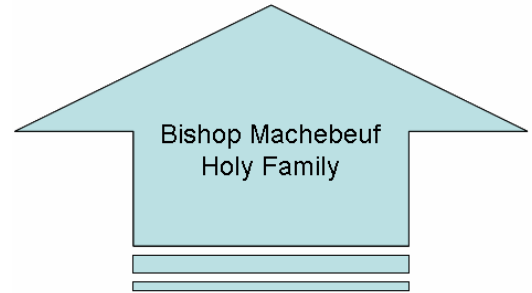
Catholic high school education investment yields dividends for college
