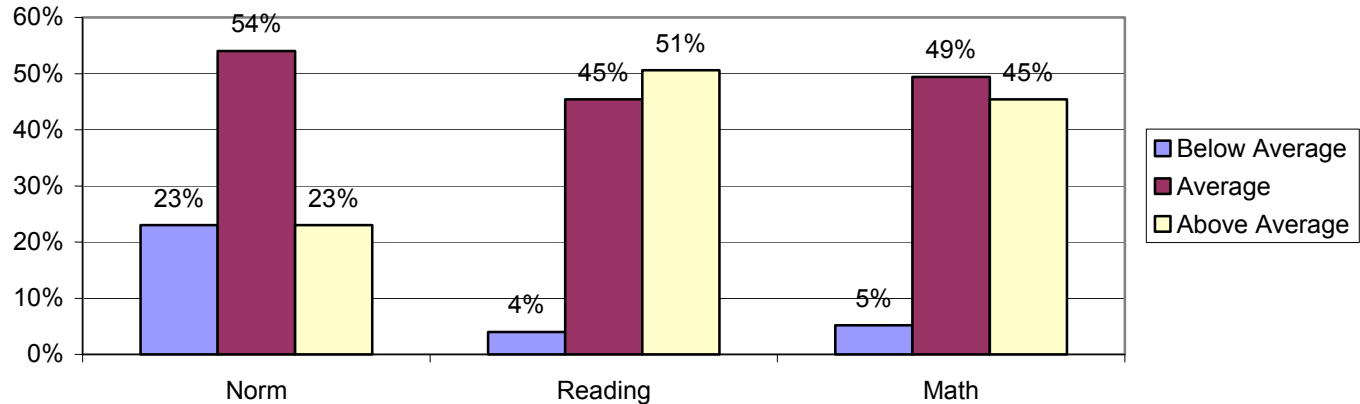


CATHOLIC SCHOOL: TAKE ANOTHER LOOK

2005 8th Grade Student Iowa Test of Basic Skills



The majority of 8th grade students in the Archdiocese of Denver score Above Average or Average in Reading and Math on the Iowa Tests of Basic Skills. “Norm” shows expected distribution of scores; that is 23% of students would score Below Average, 54% would score in the Average Range, and 23% in the Above Average range.

From this graph, it can be seen that in Reading, 4% of 8th grade students score Below Average, and more than twice as many students as the norm score in the Above Average range. In Math, 5% of students score Below Average and nearly twice as many as the norm score in the Above Average range.
