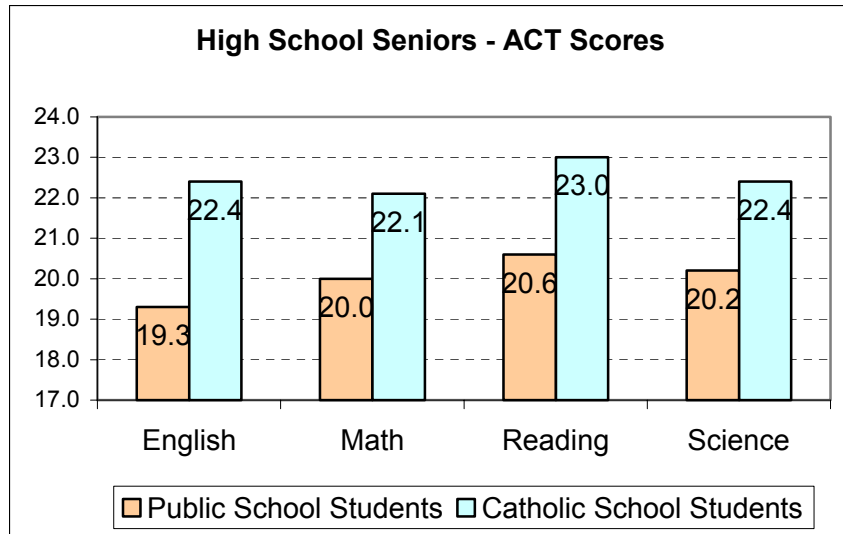

Catholic high schools are unsurpassed in academic excellence.

High school juniors and seniors take the ACT (American College Test), a widely used college entrance exam. The test is a predictor of college readiness and probable success. Colleges generally use the results of this test in admission, placement, and for awarding scholarships. The top score is 36. The graph at the right shows the average score of public high school students in Colorado compared with the average score of students attending Holy Family High School and Bishop Machebeuf.
